G.S.R. 1287.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules to amend the Directorate of National Malaria Eradication Programme (Class I post) Recruitment Rules, 1972, namely:—

1. (1) These rules may be called the Directorate of National Malaria Eradication Programme (Class I post) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 1976.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Directorate of National Malaria Eradication Programme (Class I post) Recruitment Rules, 1972.

(i) for the word and figure "Class I" wherever they occur, the word and letter "Group A" shall be substituted;

(ii) for the Schedule, the following Schedule shall be substituted, namely:—
